- One Smoke Alarm is needed for each 1,000 square feet of area, per floor. CO Alarms only have a 5 year life span.
- Combination Smoke & Carbon Monoxide Alarms MUST have a Tone and Voice Feature. If battery powered must have a 10 year sealed non rechargeable, non-replaceable battery. Revised 11-16-2021
